An early 20th century Omega gold curved rectangular cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed and jewelled movement numbered '5416430', the rectangular dial faintly detailed with Arabic numerals, the case back detailed 'Omega 5908683', case width 2.3cm, case length excluding lugs 4.5cm, weight excluding movement 14.7g (faults), together with a 9ct gold circular cased lady's wristwatch on a sprung bar link bracelet, detailed 'Albion 9c', import mark London 1920, total weight 19.6g.

Condition Report

1056. Rectangular gold case has typical surface scratches and wear. Numerous small dents. Some slight misshaping around winding hole. Both lugs repaired, the 6 o'clock end with more visible lead repair. Dial is badly worn. Movement does not wind or run, but hand set appears to be working. Case dimensions are noted in the catalogue description.

The circular watch has typical wear, surface scratches and a few small dents to case. Dial a bit dirty and worn. The movement does not wind or run, but does adjust. Case diameter 2.6cm.

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
