### LOT 1161

A late 18th century stained oak longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch square brass dial with matt centre, silvered subsidiary seconds and date aperture, within a silvered chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Fra Dorrell London', cornered by cast and pierced gilt amorini and orb spandrels, the hood with swan neck pediment above glazed door and turned columns, the trunk with rectangular door, on a plain base and plinth, height 209cm, with pendulum, two weights and winder (alterations and restoration).

Estimate: £80 - £120

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### Condition Report

1161. The later case is in fairly poor condition with splits, veneer losses and alterations. Movement is dirty and would require a service/overhaul to return to working condition. Dial is all intact, but is dirty with significant wear to silvered chapter rim and subsidiary dial. One brass cased weight is tatty and split, the other iron weight is ok.

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
