A mid-19th century French ormolu and ebonized portico mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, with nine rod pendulum, the silvered circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and two subsidiary dials and indistinctly signed, within a cast foliate ormolu surround, the rectangular top and base applied with ormolu festoons, united by four columns, on disc feet, height 62cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1156. Case in generally good order, but would require a bit of work and a good clean. Some minor splits to veneers particularly on the top. Ormolu is generally good, but very dirty. Dial is dirty and worn, missing hand to subsidiary dial. The movement does not run.
