An early 20th century walnut cased circular wall timepiece with eight day fusee movement, the backplate stamped 'Tameside No. 7810', the 12-inch painted circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'J.R. Ingram Crown St St Ives', within a moulded circular surround, case diameter 39.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.
