An Omega Automatic Seamaster 300 stainless steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1958, Ref No. 2913-4, the signed and jewelled 501 caliber movement numbered '16462242', the signed black dial with triangular luminous hour markers, Arabic hour numerals at each quarter and centre seconds, the signed case back interior numbered '2913-4', the bezel missing black Bakelite inserts, case diameter 3.8cm, on an associated spring link bracelet, with original Omega case, outer card box and alternative steel bracelet.

Estimate: £600 - £1,000

Condition Report

1090. The watch is in tired condition with scratches and wear to case and glass. It is also quite dirty. The bezel is missing Bakelite inserts. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly, but it does not run. Dial looks ok, but some loss and degrading to hour markers, but other detailing quite good. The replacement expanding strap is missing its attachment pin and has misshapen/damaged strap end. The watch lugs are in good order.
