A fine early 20th century French Transitional style kingwood and ormolu mounted secretaire a abattant, the parquetry veneered sides and fall front inset with finely painted porcelain panels, raised on slender tapering legs, height 125cm, width 56cm, depth 35cm.

Condition Report

2001. The general condition, appearance and finish is very good, however there are a few small areas of damage to the veneer. One small piece of veneer missing on edge of apron below oval panel. A small section of repaired veneer on front of left leg just below the mount. One small break and resultant area of glue to the brass trim on edge of leg near sabot. One of the legs must be slightly warped as the cabinet does not seem to sit on the floor straight, so one of the sabot may need adjusting.
