LOT 564

A Victorian gold, rose cut diamond, half-pearl and enamelled brooch, last quarter of the 19th century, mounted with five half-pearls, with a rose cut diamond set pale blue and red enamelled cruciform motif within a ropetwist surround, the back with a locket compartment, unmarked, weight 14.2g, width 3.1cm.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

Apart from a few small surface marks the enamel is in good condition. The half-pearls are in good condition with an attractive lustre. The diamonds are attractive white stones with one or two inclusions.

The pin and roll over clasp are replacements attached to the back by replacement panels. The frame to the locket compartment at the back does not sit comfortably. No glazing to the locket compartment.

The piece appears to have been altered from its original form.

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
