LOT 522

An Edwardian gold, peridot and half-pearl pendant in a scroll pierced and foliate design, collet set with a rectangular cushion cut peridot to the swing centre and an oval cut peridot to the drop, indistinct mark, length 5.8cm, with a gold curb link neckchain, detailed '585', with a replacement gilt metal boltring clasp, length 49.5cm, total weight 7.7g.

Estimate: £140 - £180

Condition Report

The oval peridot drop is bent slightly. One or two tiny nicks to the peridots evident under x10 magnification. The seed pearls might have one or two later replacements as there is some variation in lustre; some looking a little yellow, some worn, some not.

The pin/clasp is lacking from the back, with the remains of the brooch fitting evident on either side.

The chain has some minor staining in one section, possibly from a previous acid test.

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
