A gold and silver set, emerald and diamond cluster ring, mounted with the cushion cut emerald within a surround of cushion cut diamonds between split shoulders, indistinct marks, weight 2.2g, ring size approx F1/2 (two diamonds lacking), with a case.

Estimate: £140 - £180

Condition Report

The emerald is rubbed to facet edges, with a number of scratches, some deep, to the table and facets. The emerald has a few typical inclusions.

Diamonds have a few inclusions. One has a large cleavage break to one side. One or two chips to other diamonds. One or two diamonds also have some abrasion to table facet edges. Two diamonds lacking.

Silver setting showing signs of wear in places.

Split to one shoulder, another more significant split to where the head joins the side/shoulder on one side.

Split to underside edge of the head of the ring. Lacking glazing to underside of ring.

The head and shoulder of the ring possibly early Victorian, however the piece has been re-shanked in the past.

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
