Herman Moll - 'A Map of the East-Indies and the adjacent Countries; with the Settlements, Factories and Territories, explaining what belongs to England, Spain, France, Holland, Denmark, Portugal &c...!', early 18th century engraving on laid paper, 60.5cm x 101cm, within a stained wood frame.

Estimate: £600 - £1,000

Condition Report

This map is not laid down. Dampstain to the top-right corner and all the way down the right-hand edge. Much smaller stain to the top left corner. Some creasing throughout, the heaviest of which is to the top right corner. There is some foxing throughout, the majority are small spots, the most prominent and largest is to the vignette of Goa.

Torn with minor loss and repaired along the fold on the right. The other two folds have neater repaired tears. All folds appear to be reinforced.

Light age toning throughout.

The mount and backing are not archival and the mount has some damp-staining too. The frame is in good condition but does have some scratches and scuffs. There is no glass which is how we can comment on the fact it is not laid down despite not examining it out of the frame.
