### LOT 404

An Edwardian silver rectangular stamp box, the hinged lid glazed with three stamp panels, revealing a three-section interior, Chester 1901 by George Nathan & Ridley Hayes, length 8.6cm, a pair of silver engine turned napkin rings, Chester 1933 by E.J. Trevitt & Sons, and a set of six silver coffee spoons, Sheffield 1932, cased, weight of napkin rings and spoons only 134g.

### Condition Report

404 - Silver stamp box - the base is fairly misshapen and dented Otherwise minor age related wear. Width 8.6cm.

Napkin rings - both have minor age related wear but generally in good condition. Diameter 4.2cm.

Spoons - One spoon has a very dented/misshapen bowl, the others are tarnished but in good condition. Length 10cm. Case has areas of age related wear.
