A Clarice Cliff Bizarre Bonjour shape Viscaria pattern tea for two, 1930s, comprising teapot and cover, milk jug, sugar bowl, preserve pot and cover, two teacups and saucers and small plate, black printed and impressed marks to bases.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Overall the service is in good condition with no significant damage or losses/wear to the enamels.

Both saucers are crazed.

There is a flat insignificant chip to one side edge of the corner point of one cup handle.

The sugar bowl has a vertical line of horizontal scratches approx 3cm long to the brown stems of the flowers.

The preserve pot has some minor professional restoration to the edge of the cover, only noticeable if you know what you are looking for, the body of the pot has similar professional restoration to the side with the brown stems.

The teapot has an approx 1cm long glaze scratch to the top of the handle.
