A pair of Worshipful Company of Salters blue printed coat of arms plates, probably Hicks, Meigh & Johnson, the rims with floral groups, John Du Croz blue printed retailer's mark to bases, diameter 25.7cm.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

Both plates in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

One has heavy crazing to the glaze, the other has overall light surface scratches to the front and back noticeable when held in the right light.

The 'probably' attribution to Hicks, Meigh & Johnson is due to the fact Du Croz commissioned the Salter's Company Service from them - please see 'The Dictionary of Blue and White Printed Pottery 1780-1880', Volume One, A.W.Coysh & R.K.Henrywood, page117.
