A pair of Burmantofts pottery vases, late 19th century, of ovoid shape, each covered in a thick green experimental volcanic glaze, impressed marks to bases with numerals '1270', height 16cm. Note: a similar vase was sold by Woolley & Wallis, 22nd June 2017, as part of Lot 658.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

One vase has a small chip to the pooled glaze on the footrim, not visible when on a flat surface. This vase's decoration is also less in relief and therefore displays overall light surface scratches. Otherwise both vases in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
