A large Clarice Cliff Bizarre Inspiration circular charger, circa 1930, painted with a rare variant of the Inspiration Rose pattern against a shaded turquoise scale ground, blue printed and orange script factory marks, diameter 46cm (minor firing crack to footrim). Provenance: previously in the collection of Desmond Jones.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

The dish is overall in good condition with no restoration.

There is an approx 6cm long firing/haircrack to the footrim which includes 2 small chips along its length, please see the close-up images available on our website. Otherwise there is an approx 2cm long narrow rubbed area to the outer edge of the footrim opposite the firing crack which looks as though it has been rubbed somehow when the dish has been displayed. Otherwise there are some VERY glaze minor nicks around the manufactured hanging holes.

The dish has typical crazing to the glaze.
