An unusual Coalport hexagonal jar and cover, late 19th century, with moulded branch coral and shell decoration to each edge, heightened in gilt, three central panels with an oval cartouche painted with boats at sea, framed by foliate gilt decoration, raised on four shell feet, green printed mark to base, height 21cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

The jar and cover are both overall heavily crazed, with some long craze lines particularly visible through the pink glazed shoulders and then towards the lower half of the panels where they are also slightly stained. The cover also has some minor staining, the finial is glued and has a branched haircrack running over it. No restoration or chips.

The gilding and enamels remain bright and strong with no real signs of wear.
