### LOT 1662

A Royal Worcester oil lamp body and reservoir, circa 1889, the ivory grounds decorated with gilt enriched scattered flower stems beneath moulded gilt enriched borders, puce printed marks, height of body 16cm, with partial brass fittings.

### Condition Report

Both pieces are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Approx half of the gilt band on the main body beneath the moulding is almost totally worn, and the gilding to the moulding and decoration on the reservoir is completely worn.

The gilt metal reservoir interior is approx 14cm diameter; the base of the porcelain reservoir is approx 12.5cm diameter with a 1cm lip.
