## LOT 1401

A large flambé Moorcroft Lily pattern vase, mid-20th century, of pear shape, impressed marks to base with facsimile signature and blue painted initials, height 45cm (minor repair to rim).

## Condition Report

There is an approx 5cm long by 2cm deep section of the rim broken away in 2 pieces and visibly repaired with most of the original glaze remaining on the broken pieces and only a few losses along the break lines.

Otherwise the vase is in good condition overall with no cracks or restoration.

There is overall crazing to the glaze.

The photographs do not do the glaze justice, there are no eruptions or unsightly areas. It could do with a clean as there are some scattered DIY paint spots and some general dirt spots. There are also some typical but generally insignificant surface scratches only really noticeable on close inspection.
