A pair of Staffordshire Coalbrookdale cornucopia spill vases, early 19th century, enamelled and encrusted with flowers, height 16cm, together with a similar Paris porcelain cornucopia vase.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Pair of cornucopia - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, both with heavy crazing to the glaze including some longer craze lines only noticeable on close inspection. There are some typical minor losses to the applied flowers but overall they are in very good condition. Some very minor losses to the enamelling. Gilding good.

Paris cornucopia - small glued repair to edge of one foot, the other feet have some minor nicks/chips and there is a minor flat chip to the top edge of the base between the feet of the griffin. The gilding is quite worn overall, there is some minor flaking to the enamelled figures.
