A Bohemian cranberry and amber flashed engraved glass goblet vase, late 19th century, the faceted rounded bowl with a rectangular panel depicting a man with a horse, height 16cm, together with four pieces of Venetian glass and a wrythen moulded blue glass taperstick, height 8cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Goblet vase - 4 small chips to scalloped cutting of foot, only really noticeable on closer inspection, scratches and wear to top left corner of horse panel, otherwise ok with typical light surface scratches.

Blue and gilt Venetian dish - in good condition.

Venetian beaker - crack to base.

Venetian goblet - in good condition.

White and black Venetian dish - in good condition.

Blue candlestick - opening at top goes all the way through to a hole in the base of the object, small chip and rough nibbling to top rim edge of candlestick, otherwise ok.
