LOT 1775

A large pewter mounted amethyst tinted glass vase, early 20th century, the gently ribbed flared body mounted with pewter irises, height 34cm, together with a pale blue controlled bubble glass vase with pewter mounted leaves, inset with blue glass cabochons, height 20.5cm, and a black ground vase, mounted in white metal with irises, height 28cm.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Amethyst vase - tiny section of pewter loss to tip of one leaf and pewter lifting ever so slightly around footrim, both issues only noticeable on very close inspection, otherwise in good condition overall.

Blue vase - in good condition overall, some very minor spots where pewter lifting but inconsequential and negligible.

Black vase - an approx 12cm long horizontal line blemish/scratch running through lowest flower on one side, and similar smaller through stem of flowers on other side. There are a few other less noticeable light surface scratches. The mounts would benefit from a polish/clean. There are a few minor manufacturing blemishes to the black ground.
