### LOT 1665

A Dutch Delft lobed dish, circa 1700, painted in blue and manganese with Oriental figures and details, blue painted numeral to underside, diameter 31cm, together with two similar smaller dishes, diameters 20.5cm and 21.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £250 - £350

### Condition Report

Largest dish - triangular shaped dish to rim at approx 10 o'clock, mostly affecting the rim underside, approx 2cm long by 1.5cm deep, it has an associated approx 6cm long hairline running from it. There is typical minor fritting to the rim and overall typical light surface scratches/wear, most noticeable to the lobed sections of the rim.

Pale blue smaller dish - some fritting to rim, notably at 9 o'clock, quite heavily scratched, approx 2.5cm long hairline to glaze on underside edge at 6 o'clock.

Dark blue smaller dish - extensive fritting to rim edge and footrim with more noticeable approx 1.5cm by 1cm glaze chip to underside rim edge, approx 6cm long haircrack to rim at 7 o'clock, some typical light surface scratches.
