A mixed group of English porcelain cabinet plates and dishes, mostly 19th century, landscape and floral painted with a variety of coloured grounds, including a green ground Alcock rectangular shaped low comport, length 28.5cm, a Spode foliate moulded oval dish with gilt dentil rim, length 26.3cm, a Royal Crown Derby Vine plate, signed, a Derby titled botanical plate, Mintons, Bodley and Worcester (minor faults).

Condition Report

Bodley crimped rim plate - minor chip to rim underside edge.

Pair Ridgway plates with black printed and gilt chinoiserie decoration - both heavily crazed, one with minor chip to underside rim edge.

Magenta ground floral painted plate - heavily crazed.

Derby botanical plate - heavily crazed and stained.

Green ground Worcester plate signed Phillips - significant surface scratches overall.

Green ground Copeland and Garrett Felspar plate - wear and scratches to ground colour.

Pair Copeland plates with crenellated rim - one heavily crazed.

Spode oval dish - surface scratches to interior.

Remaining items in lot in generally good condition overall.
