A large assorted group of mostly English porcelain cabinet cups and some saucers, late 18th century and later, including Minton, Spode, New Hall, Wedgwood, Derby, Chamberlains and Worcester, in a variety of floral and geometric patterns (minor faults).

Condition Report

Masons faceted can with apricot and gilt rim - crazed but ok.

New Hall can with blue ground floral rim - cracked.

Magenta and gilt simple foliate band trio - each piece crazed with light staining.

Davenport Imari saucer - crazed but ok.

Coffee can with iron red and gilt foliate decoration - heavily crazed with some wear.

Spode gilt foliage cup with blue banding - saucer crazed.

Chinoiserie trio - haircrack to saucer, can chipped.

Puce, gilt and iron red floral can, cup and two saucers - each piece crazed and with other minor faults.

Minton turquoise rimmed cup and saucer - saucer cracked, cup crazed.

Remaining items in lot in generally good condition.
