A Royal Doulton cabinet plate, circa 1910, painted by J.H. Plant, signed, with a titled view of Dunluce Castle, diameter 24cm, together with a group of similar plates, including a pair by Royal Worcester, painted by Johnson with game birds, a pair with turquoise rims by Minton, painted with landscape views, a pair by Worcester, painted with yellow roses, and a smaller Worcester plate, painted by Hunt, signed, diameter 18.3cm.

Condition Report

Each item is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some typical light surface wear but nothing untoward or of any significance, the only items which have any issues are the three plates printed and painted with fruit and flowers to the centre and rim which are each crazed with some wear, and one has a very small chip to the rim underside.
