### LOT 1424

A small group of English porcelain, early 19th century, reserved with oval floral panels within gilt framing against a yellow ground, comprising a circular tureen and cover, three hors d'oeuvres dishes and four plates, unmarked (minor faults).

### Condition Report

The service is overall in good condition with no cracks or restoration. There is wear to the gilding, in varying degrees throughout, primarily seen on the rims.

The rim edge of the tureens cover has a teeny tiny nick.

One of the plates has a minuscule nick to the upper rim edge.

One of the plates has 2 very faint hairlines to the rim.

The plates are 20.5cm diameter.

The hors d'oeuvres dishes are 34cm long at the longest point.
