Three Caughley porcelain trios, circa 1790, of fluted form gilt with an undulating foliate band beneath a geometric band, together with a matching plate and a small group of other mostly English porcelain, late 18th, 19th and 20th century, including a Derby Imari coffee can, a Coalport miniature gold ground cup and saucer, and a lustre coffee can.

### Condition Report

Gilt decorated Caughley - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some minor typical wear/rubbing to the gilding.

Miniature gilt ground Coalport can and saucer - crazed, a few tiny nicks to base gilt edge of can.

Small Worcester blue floral printed cup - crazed, small chip to footrim.

Miniature Spode blue printed teacup and saucer - cup crazed, saucer cracked.

The remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with minimal wear.
