A small group of mostly English teawares, late 18th century, including a Worcester Dalhousie type cylindrical mug, painted with a circular landscape view within a gilt and turquoise frame, unmarked, height 9.3cm and a teabowl, probably New Hall, pattern No. 186 (some faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Dalhousie mug - 0.8cm flat chip to outer rim edge by handle, approx 4.5cm long vertical haircrack behind handle, a few scratches to painted panel.

Black and gilt saucer - gilding worn, 4 small nicks and short hairline to rim.

Chinese famille rose saucer - cracked and chipped.

Black and gilt teabowl - cracked with 3 small nicks to rim.

Other 3 pieces each with faults.
