A Grainger & Co Worcester reticulated vase, 1880s, the ivory ground shaped body with two opposing pierced panels within a gilt and turquoise bead framing, flanked by pierced flat handles, brown printed and painted marks to base, height 30.5cm, together with a similarly pierced blush ivory Grainger Worcester vase, height 36cm (drilled).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Ivory ground vase - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Panel to one side missing one turquoise bead, panel to other side missing 2 turquoise beads.

Blush ground vase - one flowerhead on neck with fault to the turquoise centre, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, typical light rubbing to the gilding of the rim.
