A group of mostly Worcester underglaze blue printed teawares, late 18th century, including an Argument pattern teabowl and saucer, a Mother and Child teabowl and saucer, a Man in the Pavilion coffee cup and teabowl, three coffee cups in the Three Flowers pattern and a Royal Lily trio (minor faults).

### Condition Report

One Three Flowers coffee cup cracked with light staining.

Mother and Child saucer with chips to footrim, teabowl print quite blurry.

Man in the Pavilion teabowl with fine hairline to base interior, the coffee cup with minor chip to footrim.

Royal Lily trio with some wear to gilding.

Larger saucer with wear to gilding, is a later piece.

One Fisherman and Cormorant teabowl with very blurry print.

Fence pattern teabowl with chip to rim.

Pale blue printed fluted teabowl with blue cross mark to base - gilt detail worn, footrim chipped and blemished.

Caddy lacking cover but ok.

Remaining items in lot in good condition overall.
