A Continental green glass scent bottle and stopper, late 19th century, of baluster shape with lobed and cut detail, heightened in gilt, height 15cm, together with a similar ruby flashed opaque white example, height 12cm, and a small group of other glassware, including four wines with green bowls, a rummer and five champagne saucers engraved with fruiting vine (some faults).
