A Sino-Tibetan gilt bronze figure of Avalokiteshvara, Qing dynasty or later, the four-armed bodhisattva modelled seated in dhyanasana wearing an elaborate headdress, stone embellished bead jewellery and celestial scarf, on a lotus moulded base, height 22.5cm.

Condition Report

Weight 1842g.

The figure is in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs.

The base metal plate to the underside has been pushed in along the back edge and is subsequently misshapen. There would appear to be a stone missing from the larger roundels resting on each shoulder beneath the ears, otherwise the stones all appear to be present but are very roughly finished - one amidst the headdress is possibly a replacement as it is noticeably a different colour on closer inspection.

Typical overall surface scratches and wear.
