A Japanese brown patinated bronze figure of an elephant, Meiji/Taisho period, modelled in a standing pose, indistinct small seal mark to underside, height 15.5cm, length 26cm.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

The casting of the animal has been poorly executed - as such one of the toenails on the front right foot is totally missing and there is a similar fault to the base corner edge of the right ear where it joins the body. There are also casting marks visible to the top of the back of the animal.

Otherwise there is expected but extensive wear to the underside of the feet, with typical normal wear to the body of the animal overall.

Some loose debris to interior of animal.
