### LOT 1005

A part set of Chinese famille rose export porcelain teaware, Qianlong period, comprising globular teapot and cover, sparrow beak cream jug and cover, teabowl and saucer and two coffee cups, each finely enamelled with polychrome flower sprays beneath a gilt link band, height of teapot 14.4cm (saucer and one coffee cup cracked and other minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

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### Condition Report

Teapot - in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. There is a 3.5cm horizontal hairline to the body just above the spout, otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels.

Jug and cover - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Very minor bruise to rim, typical light surface wear and scratches.

Teabowl - 2 minor chips to rim and small starcrack to base, otherwise ok with typical wear.

Saucer - 2.5cm hairline and small chip to rim, otherwise typical minor scratches and wear.

Coffee cups - first in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, typical light wear. Second with 4cm haircrack and small chip to rim, otherwise ok.

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
