A small collection of Chinese porcelain, 18th century and later, including a Nanking Cargo blue and white export porcelain teabowl and saucer, Qianlong period, painted with the pine tree pattern, saucer diameter 10.4cm, two famille rose export porcelain coffee cups, Qianlong period, one painted with figures, height 6.4cm, the other with flowers, height 5.5cm (hairline to rim), a famille rose export porcelain teabowl, and a famille rose teabowl, painted with flowers (chipped spout and lacking cover).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

Nanking Cargo teabowl and saucer - in generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs, some minor nibbles to rim of saucer and typical light surface scratches and wear.

Figural coffee cup - generally in good condition, firing crack to handle, minor chip to rim, typical light wear to enamels and gilding.

Floral coffee cup - 1cm hairline crack to rim, otherwise ok.

Famille rose teabowl - 4.5cm hairline and a 3cm hairline to rim, minor chip to rim, typical light wear.

Teapot - chipped end of spout, missing cover, otherwise decoration good and vibrant.

Bowl and stand - small chip to rim of bowl and stand, minor glaze blemishes.
