A group of Chinese export porcelain, Kangxi period and later, comprising an Imari bowl with everted rim and gilt with flowers, diameter 15cm, an Imari circular bowl, painted with flowers, diameter 17.5cm (cracked), a blue and white circular dish, diameter 16cm, and an Imari tea bowl and saucer, diameter of saucer 13.1cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Imari bowl with everted rim - generally in good condition with minor fritting/chips to rim, typical light wear to gilt.

Imari circular bowl - two approx 7.5cm vertical hairline cracks to rim, one with 6cm diagonal branching from it, minor rim chips.

Blue and white circular dish - generally in good condition, a few minor rim chips.

Imari teabowl and saucer - both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt.
