### LOT 1055

A collection of Chinese porcelain covers/lids, mostly Kangxi and Yongzheng period, including an underglaze blue, red and celadon glazed dome cover, diameter 16.2cm, ten blue and white covers, diameters ranging from 3.4cm to 13cm, and six famille rose covers (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £100

### Condition Report

1055. Blue, red and celadon cover - generally good condition with only typical minor glaze fritting/loss to edges, no cracks or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear.

Famille rose octagonal cover - generally good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear, and minor fritting/chips to edges, but no significant damage or repairs.

Famille rose octagonal with flowers and insects - minor glaze loss to tip of finial and typical light fritting to edges. Minor wear to enamels and gilt.

Large blue and white cover - chips to edges of rim, otherwise ok.

Famille rose petal decorated cover - glaze loss to finial and chips to rim, typical wear.

Famille verte cover with red finial - very small chip to rim, otherwise good.

Small blue and white cover painted with three precious objects - faint hairline crack across centre of cover, otherwise ok.

All other covers in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Most with typical light surface scratches and wear.
