LOT 1157

A collection of sixteen Chinese hardwood stands, late 19th century and later, including an oval stand with carved apron and scroll legs united by undertier, length 21.5cm, and a dish stand, carved with prunus, height 28.5cm, together with a Chinese wood box with sliding cover and silk mounted interior, length 20cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Oval stand with carved apron - indistinct split to corner edge of one foot and minor horizontal split to another foot, couple of minor and indistinct nicks to edges, nothing really noticeable, and minor typical wear to edges.

Prunus carved dish stand - one foot of vertical strut rubbed down ever so slightly to probably disguise chip, reverse of one foot of dish support with minor chip, horizontal strut poorly reattached at some stage.

Light brown inkstand dish, 25 by 12cm - bruise/chip to one top corner, another corner with minor chip, surface scratches, otherwise ok.

Circular tiered stand - 10cm high, drilled, overall surface wear and minor blemishes, generally good.

Circular stand with five feet - 12cm diameter - minor chip to one piece of carving, generally ok.

Circular stand 15cm diameter - noticeable chip to one foot with small split alongside.

Circular stand 10.5cm diameter - manufacturing joins splitting and opening up, noticeable across diameter of stand.

Circular stand 12.5cm diameter - ok

Oblong stand, 12.5cm long - minor typical wear to edge of foot, light digs to upper surface.

Pair circular stands 6cm diameter - both ok.

Light brown circular stand, 7cm diameter - ok.

5 small circular stands, 4 to 5cm diameter - all ok.

Box - fitted silk lined interior has light staining, otherwise ok.
