A Chinese famille rose turquoise ground porcelain saucer dish, mark of Qianlong but later Qing dynasty, painted with a dense design of flowers and leafy tendrils, iron red four-character mark to base, diameter 23.3cm (minor rim repair).

Estimate: £500 - £700

Condition Report

Flat chip broken away from upper rim edge in 2 pieces, approx 1.3cm long by 0.5cm wide, and visibly poorly glued with minor losses along the break lines.

The dish would benefit from a clean, but does have noticeable and in some cases significant glaze scratches/wear to the upper surface.

The enamels are overall bright and good with some minor wear to the rim.

The turquoise enamel has not properly covered the base all the way to the circumference edge of the inner footrim - please see the extra images on our website using the zoom function.
