A Japanese inlaid lacquer rectangular panel, Meiji period, inlaid in bone, ivory and mother-of-pearl with a sparrow holding a grasshopper in its beak beneath flowers, leaves and bamboo, on a black lacquered ground,  $67 \text{cm} \times 32 \text{cm}$ , gilt framed.

## **Condition Report**

1236. The panel is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. There appears to be one small piece of inlay missing to the bird's back claw, and a small replaced/repaired piece of inlay to the lowers section of vine on the left side of the image. Otherwise all inlay appears to be present and in decent order. Black lacquer ground with typical minor scratches and wear.
