### LOT 1174

A Chinese blue and white export porcelain circular bowl, Yongzheng period, painted inside and out with flowers, diameter 27.5cm (cracked and chipped), together with a Chinese Canton famille rose Islamic market circular bowl, mid-19th century, painted with typical figural, bird and flower panels, the exterior with two gilt roundels filled with Islamic script, diameter 19.7cm (repaired).

### Condition Report

1174. Blue and white bowl - an area of chipping around the rim (approx 9cm in length) with a 6.5cm vertical hairline running down from the rim. Also a 9cm hairline crack to other side of rim. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze of bowl interior. Good vibrant blue decoration.

Canton bowl - broken into numerous pieces and restored with overpainting.
