### LOT 1051

A Chinese famille rose porcelain bowl and cover/stand, early 20th century, each of fluted circular form, painted with flowers and insects, iron red painted seal marks, height 7.7cm (minor chips), and a collection of other Chinese porcelain, including a circular two-section dish, painted with flowers, diameter 9.4cm, and a pair of Canton yellow ground cylindrical boxes and covers, painted with birds, butterflies and flowers, height 9.2cm (one cracked), together with a Japanese porcelain bottle, height 18.2cm (cracked).

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

1051. Bowl and stand/cover - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Some very minor chips to rim of bowl and minor wear to gilt and enamels.

Two-section dish - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Minor glaze blemish to rim and typical light wear to glaze and enamels.

Cylindrical box 1 - small hairline crack to body and small chip to rim of cover, otherwise ok.

Cylindrical box 2 - chips to rim of cover, otherwise good condition.

Chinese vase - chip and hairline to rim, typical light wear to decoration.

Japanese vase - three cracks to body and typical wear.

Famille rose stand - chip to footrim and typical wear to gilt and enamels.

Rice grain cup - good condition.

Blue and white bowl - cracked.

Small teapot - minor rim chips.
