LOT 616

A gold, opal and diamond ring, early 20th century, mounted with three oval opals with two pairs of rose cut diamonds at intervals, indistinct mark, weight 1.8g, ring size approx G1/2.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

All three opals are heavily worn, one side opal has a chip towards the girdle on one side.
The opals display a strong blue/green play-of-colour.
Typical light wear and scratching to the shank, some thinning at the back of the shank.
The ring has possibly been resized in the past next to the mark, which is now indistinct.

Principal opal approx. 5.5mm x 4.1mm x 3.2mm

Side opals approx. 3.0mm x 3.3mm x 1.1mm

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
