A pair of 19th century and later mahogany bookcase cabinets, each with a moulded pediment above two lancet glazed doors and cupboards, on bracket feet, height 217cm, width 114cm, depth 45cm (alterations).

Condition Report

2219. Overall both would benefit from professional restoration, but are relatively solid and functional. Both feel quite 'made-up', probably in the early/mid-20th century using older parts of bookcases. There are five shelves for the two bookcases.

First cabinet - piece of cornice detached, but present. Lacking locks to interior. Crack to right cupboard door. Damage to moulding on right cupboard door.

Second cabinet - lacking lockplates to all doors. One glazed door does not open freely and scrapes on the cupboard below. Age related cracks down both sides of cupboards.
