A large George III and later mahogany 'D' end triple pedestal dining table, the top with a wide satinwood crossbanded border, raised on reeded sabre legs with brass caps and castors, the locking mechanism stamped 'Bullock 90 Wardour St', height 75.5cm, total length 390cm, depth 158cm. Note: from the contents of Runnymede Park, Surrey.

Condition Report

2168. One 'D' end has a large split from the rim in towards the centre (approx 50cm). The other 'D' end has a separation split right the way through. The large leaf is stained and the cross-banded veneer also has age related cracks. General age related wear.

Largest leaf measures 157.5cm x 78cm. Two smaller leaves measure 157.5cm x 51.5cm, and are a lighter colour than the rest of the table.
