An Edwardian 9ct gold and woven hair work mourning ring, the front with a heart shaped motif, the shank inset with a band of woven hair work, otherwise with engraved decoration, Chester 1903, ring size approx Q, together with a late Victorian gold mourning ring, the front glazed with an oval woven hair locket compartment between decorated shoulders, detailed '9ct', ring size approx U, total weight 5g.

Condition Report

Heart motif ring - minor surface wear to the gold work, the heart motif has a few fine old scratches at the bottom, the hallmark is in fairly good condition.

Locket compartment ring - inside of the locket is slightly grubby, otherwise in good condition.

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
