An early Victorian 18ct gold mourning ring, the front mounted with an oval glazed woven hair locket compartment, engraved to the exterior of the shank 'Warner Ottley 1846 Aet 71', London 1846, weight 4.7g, ring size approx O1/2.

Condition Report

The shank was likely enamelled but this is now missing. The inscription to the shank is generally rather worn. The glazing to the locket has been polished in an attempt to buff out the surface scratching and wear.

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
