A 19th century mahogany fold-over concertina-action dining table, in the manner of Wilkinson of Moorfields, London, the top with two additional leaves, raised on turned legs and substantial brass caps and castors, height 73cm, depth 122cm, extended length 192cm (bearing stamps to frame but possibly later added).

Condition Report

2160. The table does not have any clips, but does seem to be solid and flat when extended, and would feel more solid when clips are fitted. Both leaves appear to be original, but are typically slightly different in colour. There are some overall surface scratches and scuffs throughout, particularly to the edges of both leaves. One of the decorative turned roundels is missing to the frieze and there has been a small professionally added extension to the rear edge of the frieze, probably added to give extra support to the leaf. Some evidence of very minor and historic woodworm to underneath.
