A Vacheron & Constantin steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1950s, the signed jewelled P454/58 caliber movement numbered '528792', the signed dial with gilt hour batons, the signed case back interior numbered '359321' over '4217', case diameter 3.3cm, on a brown leather strap.

Condition Report

1045. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently keeping good time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The watch appears to be in generally good clean condition. There are a couple of stress cracks to the edge of the crystal at approx 6 o'clock. Case in good order, but with typical minor surface scratches. Dial is clean with only minor degrading around edges of hour batons and other minor dirt specks. Lettering to the dial is very bright and clear, possibly re-touched/painted.

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
