LOT 1105

A late 19th century French lacquered brass oval cased carriage clock by Drocourt, with eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the backplate with stamped maker's mark and numbered '10217', the circular enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minutes, within a matt gilt surround, the oval case with swing handle and bevelled glass panels, height 17.7cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1105. Both trains wind smoothly but it is not currently running. The striking mechanism and repeat is working as it should.

The lacquer to the case is a bit worn.

Glass panels appear to be in generally good condition, but back door panel has minor chip to top left corner.

Hinge to back door is good.

Dial is good and clean, and matt gilt surround in good order.

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
